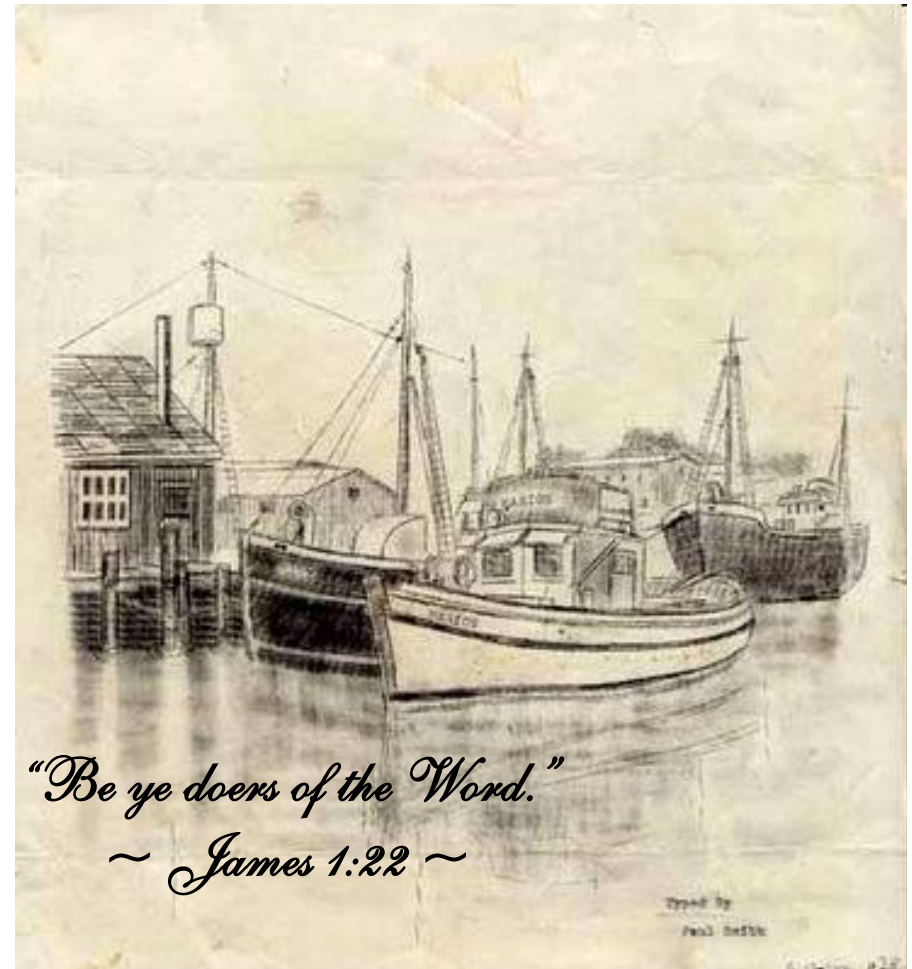
FEBC SCHOLARSHIPS
