Pastoral Profile



Position

Christian Fellowship Chapel is seeking a Pastor to lead our Church family. A description of Christian Fellowship Chapel can be found in the Church profile that is available on request.

The Pastor is answerable to, and is a part of, the Elder Board, who provide spiritual direction, plan worship, and provide discipline within the Church.

The Pastoral position is a paid full time position.

The Pastor is responsible to lead a teaching ministry within the Church, largely delivered by preaching during Sunday morning services, to provide compassionate support to Church members, and to officiate at Church functions such as Baptisms, Marriages and Funerals. The Pastor is also responsible for counselling congregation members where appropriate and if the skills exist.

In addition, the Pastor is expected to provide leadership along with the Elders to develop a vision for the Church such that it is answering the call that God has for the Chapel. We believe that this call includes a focus on young people and young adults as well as friendship evangelism while maintaining our emphasis on Bible learning, prayer,

and the fellowship of the congregation.

The Pastor is also expected to perform administrative tasks such as responding to the Church email box, Chapel phone messages, allowing service staff into the building, and other small tasks as required.

The Pastor is supported by the Elder Board, by the Deacons — who help meet the physical and spiritual needs of the congregation — and by the Administration Council.

Details about the organization of the Chapel and specific duties can be provided in the Chapel Constitution which is available upon request.

Qualifications

Must Be...

- A Christian man - A born-again believer who has recognized himself as a sinner, and has accepted the gift of Salvation only available through the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.
- Eligible for ordination with the Fellowship of Evangelical Bible Churches
- An experienced Bible teacher and able to Preach based on deep doctrinal understanding of the Bible and from the experience of his own Christian walk
- In agreement with the Christian Fellowship Chapel Doctrinal Statements. (Available upon request)

With Preference for...

- Education in the form of a degree from a recognized Bible College or Seminary
- Experience in Pastoring a congregation
- A family
- Passion for, knowledge of, and experience in working with teens and young adults
- Passion for, knowledge of, and experience in lifestyle evangelism and Discipleship

The Pastoral Search

The Pastoral Search Committee is actively searching for a Pastor for Christian Fellowship Chapel. We are led by prayer and the support of the Elder Board and the congregation. We have surveyed the congregation to better understand their needs as well as working with the vision for the Chapel that the Elder Board has developed. We are

seeking the common understanding that God has called a Pastor into His service.

The selection of a Pastor will be done following the Pastoral Search Committee recommendation to the Elder Board, candidating before the congregation, and then a vote of acceptance by the Church members.

The position is vacant now so we are interested on bringing a Pastor into the Chapel as soon as possible
