- "Walk as Jesus Walked".

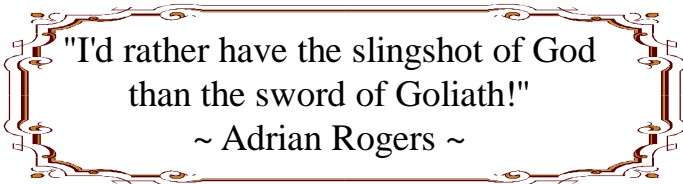
The conference will offer workshops in many areas such as addictions and people at risk.
